

SCHEDULE 8

QUALIFICATION FOR THE COUNTY BADGE

8.1 The President(s) of the Association.

8.2 Any player who has acquired 30 points and has played in the Round of 16 of a Major Competition or any Preliminary Round due to Proportional Representation, or the last 8 of a Minor Competition.

8.3 A non-badged member playing in the National Championship Finals shall be awarded their County Badge irrespective of the number of points accrued. This rule shall not apply to substitutes who have entered at the last 16 stage or later.

8.4 A man playing in his first Middleton Cup match shall be presented with a Middleton Cup blazer badge.

8.5 A lady playing in her first Johns Trophy match shall be presented with a Johns Trophy flash.

8.6 A non-badged lady playing in her first Johns Trophy match shall be presented with a County blazer badge and Johns Trophy flash.

8.7 A player playing in the Semi Final or Final of the White Rose National County Junior Two Fours Competition Trophy or the Amy-Rose Bowl - 31's & under Inter-County Double Rink shall be presented with a County Badge.

8.8 A player who wins a National Competition administered by Bowls England shall be awarded a County Badge.
