

**REPORT OF MEETING OF THE COMPETITIONS COMMITTEE
AND THE SECTION COMPETITION SECRETARIES HELD ON
OCTOBER 3RD 2019**

It was agreed that in the last 16 of the Ladies' Major Competitions that the games be played on a neutral green half-way between the Clubs involved. The neutral green would be arranged by the challengers. This round would remain on a play-on date, but could be arranged to be played before that date and could be played at any time of day by mutual agreement.

It was agreed to recommend to the Executive Committee that the "C" places should be removed. The final stages of the County Trophy would be for the Section winners only.

It was decided that the Competitions Committee should look at the Points system to see if changes were needed or could be made. This followed a proposal from Section 6 that a badge could be awarded if a player reached 50 points but had failed to reach an out-of-section round.

The process of informing players who their opponents were when the Competitions reached the latter stages would be tightened up for next season.

The Committee would pass their findings on the question of trophies to the Executive Committee.

The fact that some players had not turned up for the final stages of some of the competitions and a team had arrived late for the finals of the Foxlands had been dealt with by the Men's Administrator.

It had been agreed that as far as possible the finals of the Major Competitions be centralised was the reason why no finals were scheduled to take place in Section 1.
